

# Angel Trumpet

If you are growing your Angel's Trumpets in the garden, they should be planted in a sheltered area in light, fertile, well-drained soil. In most areas, they will grow and flower best in full sun, but in hot, dry climates they will appreciate light shade or mottled sunlight, especially during hot, mid-day sun.



This is a very thirsty plant that needs to be watered well—and often. If growing an Angel Trumpet in a pot, ensure there are ample drainage holes at the base, so the plant doesn't get waterlogged. Root rot can occur if the soil becomes soggy.

All parts of the Angel Trumpet are toxic to humans and pets if ingested.

This is a tropical plant that will be stunted by temperatures below 50 degrees and will die with frost. It is suggested that you grow your Angel Trumpet in a pot and bring inside for the winter.

<b>Exposure:</b>	Full sun
<b>Soil:</b>	Well-drained
<b>Bloom time:</b>	Mid-summer to early autumn
<b>Flower color:</b>	Blue, purple, white
