

Indian Pink, (Spigelia), Little Redhead

Native American wild flower



Early Spring Bloomer---dies back with the frost. Likes moisture but thrives in sandy full sun location.

Sharp contrast between dark green leaves and yellow tipped red flowers. 24 inches tall and clumps to 18" diameter.

Clusters of elongate flower buds are formed at the top of each stem, and mature to a vibrant scarlet red. Each flower opens with 5-pointed petals that create an intense yellow star at the top of the floral corolla. This is a native hummingbird-attracting plant.
