Jagus Ratrayii Crinum

Crinum jagus is native to tropical Africa. The variety called *rattrayi* has very attractive rigid, wide, upright foliage. The flowers are huge and have a very pleasant vanilla-like fragrance and the foliage is very attractive by itself. A single bulb will grow to a clump with a height of 4 feet high and 3 feet in diameter within 4 years. The foliage is stunning with an upright form. Does very well in the shade. A personal favorite (Milt) crinum. The bulb will take 3-4 years after planting to grow to blooming and offset making size. Tolerates full sun but does better in shade.



Tender leaves will die with light frost. Mulch around bulbs. Fertilize yearly.
