Mexican sunflower Tithonia comes in vibrant orange and yellow versions.

The original plant is six feet tall with fuzzy dark green foliage and an abundance of bright orange flowers from early summer to fall. Smaller versions are available. The stems can get 2 inches in diameter like all sunflowers. This is the most prolific of all butterfly attractors. The plant reseeds prolifically and can be a minor nuisance but are thinned easily. Full sun. Not fussy about soil type. No need to fertilize.

Gets 6 feet high and 4 feet in diameter.
