## Parsley Hawthorn: Crataegus marshallii

A native hawthorn from Texas to the Carolinas is a very attractive 10- to 15-foot-tall spring blooming and red berry bearing tree. The leaves have an Italian parsley appearance.





Red berries persist in winter if not eaten by birds. Very hardy and tolerant of neglect. Can live in sand—tolerates dryness when mature.

A spring substitute for the dying dogwoods of Tallahassee.
