Spotted Silver Manfreda



Manfreda is a tender succulent similar but more floppy than agave and mangrave species. It likes full sun but may need to be pulled out of the garden in the winter. The roots can rot if they stay wet after a frost. It offsets easily.

When Manfreda reaches mature size after several years, each clump will be topped with fascinating 3' tall flower spikes with spidery flowers. Unlike their cousins, agaves, manfredas don't die after flowering.
