

Summer Nocturne



A favorite that is often overlooked is 'Summer Nocturne'

This bulb has a sweet fragrance that will knock your socks off! I would suggest planting it with the top 1/3 of the bulb above the ground.

A blush colored crinum with nice rosettes of foliage, the 'Summer Nocturne' blooms well throughout the summer from July to fall and is widely adapted to various soil conditions.

It spreads to make a luscious ground cover and has cut, light pink flowers in August and through late fall.

This small variety tops out at 3 feet – and is great for containers.

Tolerates light shade.

Don't plant this one too deep — just 4-6 inches or so.
