Yesterday Today and Tomorrow

Yesterday Today and Tomorrow is an attractive flowering shrub for Florida landscapes. Bearing a blanket of blooms in white, lavender and purple, the Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow plant is a rare source of purpleblue tones when it comes to tropical plants. Even better is the fact that it's a reliable bloomer in all but the hottest locations.

On day one the bloom is deep purple, on day 2 it lightens to blue and day 3 it becomes almost white-hence the name. It is frost



sensitive but the roots if mulched survive hard frosts.

Grows to about 4 feet tall and 4 feet in diameter.

Plus, it *thrives* in the shade. The Yesterday is unique when it comes to flowering shrubs since it grows well in shady areas, including under tree canopies. But no matter where you plant it, from foundation plantings between windows to borders along fences or even in containers next to your door, it can grow to a large, full size with plenty of vibrant colors.

A word of caution: all parts of yesterday-today-and-tomorrow contain poisonous alkaloids. The berries are especially toxic.
